What is Community Bowl?

The Community Bowl campaign is a month-long, competitive food and fundraising drive intended to inspire a healthy competition between the cities in Galveston County and help raise critical support for the Galveston County Food Bank. Community Bowl calls upon supporters to not just get involved, but to work to inspire their friends and family to get involved as well.

The Galveston County Food Bank appreciates the commitment of our city officials and chambers of commerce as they get ready to help fight hunger throughout their community in this 2nd annual event.

How it works:

The campaign is based off a point system. For every dollar donated, you will receive 10 points. For every person that comes in to volunteer their time on your behalf, you will receive 5 points. Lastly, for every 1 lb. of food collected you will get 1 point. In order to set the bar high, we will create new incentives each week to keep the competitive spirit up! You will receive campaign updates and incentives every Monday, along with the previous week's results.

Financial Donations:

One of the best ways to help is to donate money. For every \$1 donated, the Galveston County Food Bank can provide enough food for 4 meals.

- Collect and/or mail financial donations to the Food Bank.
Ask donors to complete the attached donation form located within this packet or it can be found on our web site at, www.galvestoncountyfoodbank.org. You may also send a list of donors so the Food Bank can properly credit donations to your organization.

Food Donations:

You can donate food, household cleaners and personal hygiene items to the Food Bank.

- 10 bins will be set up around the City of League City. (Library, City Hall, Public Safety Building, Streets Building, Sportsplex and Hometown Heroes)

Volunteers:

Each volunteer will earn 5 points toward your overall contribution for each volunteer shift (2 hours) worked between September 1st and September 30th. Volunteer opportunities are available Monday – Friday between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. and Saturday between 8:30 a.m. and noon.

Tips for volunteer group:

- Friends and family are welcome; their service will count toward the organization's overall goal. Children may participate, but for safety reasons must be over the age of 12 and accompanied by an adult.
- Volunteers to sign in and to include your organization's name once at the Food Bank. This is the only way to ensure you receive credit!
